RE: Presidential Departmental Excellence in Safety Award Open

The Offices of the President, Provost and Vice President for Research & Innovation support an annual award to recognize departments and academic units for exemplary commitment to continuous improvement of a positive safety culture on campus. The receiving department must expend the \$25,000 award to continue safety program improvement.

It is once again our pleasure to announce the opening of the application cycle for the <u>Presidential Departmental Excellence in Safety Award</u>. Applications must be submitted by Friday, March 21, through the <u>Texas Tech Competition Space (InfoReady)</u>.

Within the application, submitters must showcase evidence of their improvements and excellence in safety, discuss how they have integrated safety into scholarly activities and propose a plan for the award funds to further safety programs. All university departments and academic units are encouraged to apply for the award. Past award recipients must wait five years before a new application may be submitted. Academic units may contact Environmental Health & Safety for safety metrics to include in applications.
